Parking

There is street parking around the Club, but please note the Club's car park is for members only. There is no parking in Rawson Street in front of the Club however there is parking in Bridge St which runs through the roundabout before the section of Rawson Street where the club is located. There is parking in Rawson St between Bridge St and Chesterfield Rd, also in Victoria St, which runs behind the club and crosses Bridge St.

Public Transport

By car, the Club is a 20 minute drive from the city and a few minutes from the M2 Motorway. The Club is easily accessible from the west via the Cumberland Highway or from the north from either Pennant Hills Road or Epping Road.

By train, the Club is just a few minutes' walk from Epping Railway Station.

Bus stations are located on Oxford Street and Beecroft Road. A short walk through The Epping Club Walk brings you to the Club.
